KIT CHECK-IN


Kits are received and checked in during the third week of class with your Administrator or Instructor.



(Effective 2/26/2024)

"LJIC" used in this document refers to La' James International College

Monday through Friday
 Black LJIC Shirt, Black Bottoms, Shoes (as specified below) and LJIC Name Badge

Black LJIC Shirts

- Tops must be clean and free from wrinkles.
- No colored camisoles need to be black or white ONLY
- You may wear a solid black or white long sleeve shirt, turtleneck or camisole under your LJIC shirt, and a solid black cardigan, jacket or sweater if you are cold.
 - No hoodies or pull over jackets or sweaters.
- If the LJIC shirts become stained, torn, faded or unacceptable to wear, you will be required to purchase new ones.

Black Bottoms

- · Clean and free from wrinkles.
- Solid black both in color, design and fabric.
- · Business casual or dress.
- No faded or pants with holes, no shorts, no athletic or wind pants.
- · Pants must not drag on the floor or be frayed at the bottom.
- Skirts must be no shorter than knee length.

Shoes

- · Must be in good repair and clean.
- Only soft soled shoes are permitted when scheduled in the spa.
- No flip-flops. (A rubber-soled sandal attached to the foot by only a thong between the big toe and the next toe.)

Head Coverings

- If head coverings are worn only solid black head wraps are acceptable.
- Face masks are optional. Students are to provide their own face masks if they choose to wear one.

- Flip Flops


