"LJIC" used in this document refers to La' James International College

Monday through Saturday
 Black LJIC Shirt, Black Bottoms, Shoes (as specified below) and LJIC Name Badge

Black LJIC Shirts

- Tops must be clean and free from wrinkles.
- No colored camisoles need to be black or white ONLY
- You may wear a solid black or white long sleeve shirt, turtleneck or camisole under your LJIC shirt, and a solid black cardigan, jacket or sweater if you are cold.
 - o No hoodies or pull over jackets or sweaters.
- If the LJIC shirts become stained, torn, faded or unacceptable to wear, you will be required to purchase new ones.

Black Bottoms

- · Clean and free from wrinkles.
- Solid black both in color, design and fabric.
- Business casual or dress.
- No faded or pants with holes, no shorts, no athletic or wind pants.
- Pants must not drag on the floor or be frayed at the bottom.
- Skirts must be no shorter than knee length.

Shoes

- Must be in good repair and clean.
- Only soft soled shoes are permitted when scheduled in the spa.
- No flip-flops. (A rubber-soled sandal attached to the foot by only a thong between the big toe and the next toe.)

Head Coverings

- If head coverings are worn only solid black head wraps are acceptable.
- · Face masks are optional. Students are to provide their own face masks if they choose to wear one.

- Pants with holes or frayed bottoms

- Colored Camisoles

- Flip Flops

- Low-rise Pants

- Scarves

- Hats or Caps

CLINICAL PRACTICUMS

Students are required to use LJIC trackers to track classroom work and clinical practicums performed on manikins, fellow students and guests/clients. The completion of your LJIC tracker will determine your clinical practicum grade. Clinical practicums are not individually graded.

Students are expected to complete services when they are assigned to be in the salon or spa. However, clinical practicums are not required to be performed on paying guests/clients, nor are students required to recruit guests/clients for clinical practicums. Guests/clients who contact LJIC to schedule an appointment may request specific students. Otherwise, appointments are assigned to qualified and available students in accordance with the "Guest/Client Recruitment and Appointments" section of the Student Catalog.
